

Bulletin – Australia. Brisbane Flooding update

Update – the situation has improved however the below gives more updated information regarding deliveries

8th March

With rain predicted to continue, expect continued delays until further notice. However, M1 freeway linking SYD to BNE is opening up, which should begin to see *some* reduction in those delays. Although that is subject to change.

QLD

Some delays due to road closures will continue, with many businesses remaining closed due to the clean-up effort.

NWS

Rain is forecast for the rest of the week in both NSW (and QLD) and with areas of Sydney under evacuation, assume that delays experienced to date will continue; particularly across the Sydney metropolitan area.

Based on the current forecast, we are still expecting services across the board to be impacted for the next 7 -10 days

The safety of our people is our priority. Deliveries will recommence as quickly as possible once it is safe to do so.

- QLD / Northern NSW
 - We have flooded depots
 - Limited access to sites
 - Business closures
 - Homes with no access
 - Operating with a skeleton staff
 - Power outages in some regions
