

AUSTRALIA HEAVY RAINS/FLOODS – 21st NOVEMBER 2022

UPDATE

Please be advised of the following updated information received from our office in Australia.

The forecast rain and storms have eased with only minimal rain and possible storm activity forecast this week, whilst the flooding levels are starting to subside in most areas there has been some significant damage to housing and infrastructure with repair work underway and ongoing, Flood warnings remain in place for multiple creeks and rivers as waters continue to run off.

The next 24 hours the east coast SA / VIC / TAS / & NSW are forecasting further dangerous winds in excess of 100km, over the past 24 hours these winds have caused some significant damage in VIC and SA with power outages in some areas.

Severe weather warnings have been issued across **NSW**, from Sydney's CBD down south to Eden and parts of the Central Tablelands, Riverina, Hunter and Central West Slopes, Dangerous winds are also forecast for large parts of **Victoria**, including Central, East Gippsland, Southwest, Northern Country, North Central, North East, West and South Gippsland, Wimmera and parts of Mallee Forecast Districts, **South Australia** - Adelaide, Mount Gambier, Maitland, Murray Bridge, Kingscote and Naracoorte are all under severe weather warnings

New South Wales

Northwest NSW Region:

- Narrabri - Narrabri continues to be heavily impacted by flooding occurring in regional NSW.
- Wee Waa – Restricted services with multiple road closures
- Boggabri – Restricted services with multiple road closures
- Gunnedah – Restricted services with multiple road closures

Southwest NSW Region:

- Orange Depot
 - Forbes has partially opened - Freight will start moving into some areas of Forbes today
 - Eugowra & Gooloogong inaccessible due to Flooding
 - Roads closed between Bourke, Brewarrina & Walgett
 - Condobolin partially Accessible
- Wagga Depot
 - Flooding at Narrandera some road closures in place due to water over the road
 - Sturt highway closed at Gillenbah, detours in place
 - Balranald not accessible due to flood waters
 - Flooding at Hay, some road closures due to flood waters
- Albury
 - Riverina Hwy Corowa to Urana - closed
 - Riverina Hwy Lowesdale to Savernake - closed
 - Bogong High Plains Rd (C531) closed between Mt Beauty and Falls Creek
 - Gooramadda - some roads closed
 - Wangaratta - some roads closed

Victoria:

Localised flooding occurring at Goomalibee (3673) and Tungamah (3728). Currently unable to access these areas
