1st Report

The state of NSW has once again been impacted by heavy rainfall that is severely impacting the movement of people around the entire state of NSW.

It is expected we will see some delays for all shipments arriving via the SYD hub over the next 24-48 hours with further flooding forecast and potential access being restricted.

The safety of our people is a priority and any shipments impacted as a result will be delivered as quickly as possible once it is safe to do so

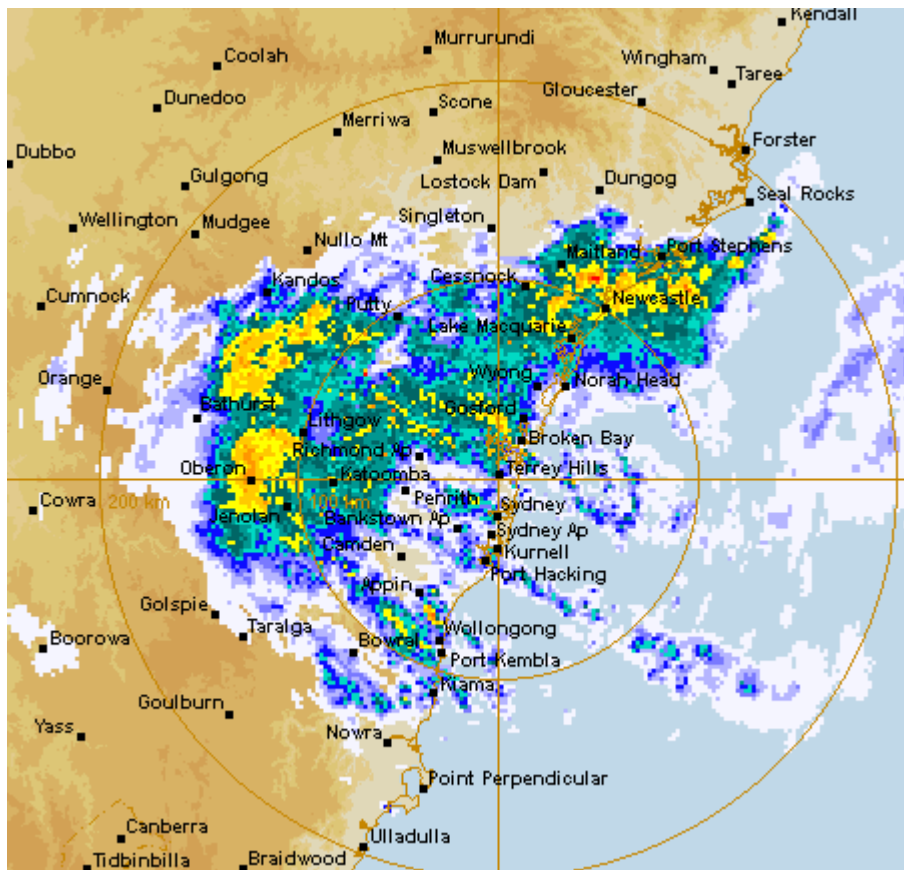
