

## Bulletin – Australia Prohibited Items list for Christmas

### PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

As we approach the festive season we wish to remind you of the prohibited items sent into Australia during this period:

Do not send:

- bark or straw based goods.
- fresh or dried conifer.
- fresh fruit and vegetables.
- fresh or dried holly.
- fresh or dried mistletoe.
- hampers (containing certain food, meat or plant material)
- pine cones.
- potpourri.
- Wood
- Xmas trees/wreaths pre decorated with pine cones
- Xmas trees unless stated artificial.

This is a selection of festive items commonly sent during this season but if you are in any doubt please do not hesitate to contact our cs team. If these shipments are received and sent to destination they will be declared to border force and will attract a quarantine/biosecurity fee for inspection which is somewhere in the region of aus\$160 which is payable even if the inspection confirms the good are allowed entry. They may have been highlighted due to their description of contents.
