



STORM NANGKA - HONG KONG/MACAU

12TH/13TH OCTOBER 2020

PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

According to the current forecast track, Nangka will be closest to Hong Kong tonight and tomorrow morning, skirting within about 500km to the south of Hong Kong. Together with the combined effect with the northeast monsoon, local winds are expected to strengthen gradually during the overnight period. The squally showers associated with Nangka will also gradually affect the coast of Guangdong. Depending on the local wind condition, the Observatory will consider issuing the Gale or Storm Signal No. 8 before dawn tomorrow morning (13 Oct). Members of the public should take note of the latest weather bulletin before departing home tomorrow morning.
