



UAE – CUSTOMS THRESHOLD AMENDMENT – EFFECTIVE 6th March 2023

Please be advised of the following information received from our office in Dubai:-

Kindly note that the high value threshold in Dubai has been revised back to the previous value from AED 300 / US\$ 81 to AED 1000 / US\$ 272 until further notice.

5% Customs Duty will be applicable for any shipment valued AED 1000 / US\$ 272 or higher, in addition to Admin fees of AED 65 / US\$ 18.

Tobacco, tobacco products, e-cigarettes, nicotine liquid, alcohol beverages and foods containing alcohol are excluded from the exemption of threshold of AED 300 / US\$ 81 as the duties tariff is different and requires other approvals for clearance. Additionally all non-document shipments imported into the UAE will be subject to 5% VAT (no changes in VAT process). Note:- In the event the consignee refuses to pay duty or refuses to accept the shipment, the relevant charges will be billed back to the origin Station i.e. 5% duty from invoice value CIF + admin fee.
